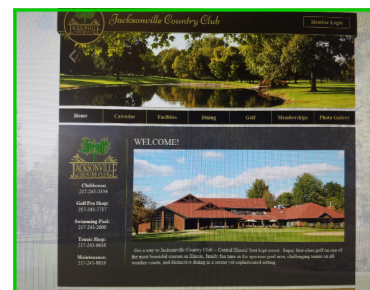

From the Golf Course Superintendent

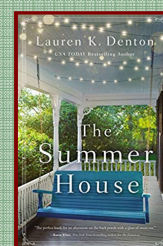

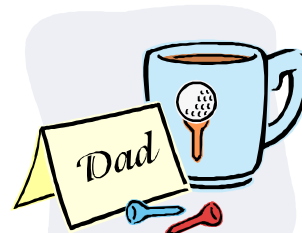
