This summer has been rather hot the past few weeks. These conditions are nothing new to a Midwest summer. Earlier in the month, we saw above average rainfall and mild temperatures that made for favorable turf growing conditions. The higher humidity has helped us keep the greens moist which lends to desired playing conditions.

Throughout the month of July, we applied selective herbicide to the fairways and green surrounds to help clean up broad leaf weeds and any other leafy weeds that may have appeared as the poa declined. We have seen improved results with our weed control program throughout the course. We have continued to

trim trees around the course to improve playability for members and guests. We are excited for the Club Championship that will be held this month.



The maintenance staff hopes that everyone is enjoying the nice summer weather and enjoying all activities around the club. We hope to have a great rest of the summer and an even better fall.
